1) SUBPROGRAMME TO PROMOTE DOCTORAL TRAINING (PREDOCS)

In relation to the Resolution of 3 October 2024 of the University of the Balearic Islands, which announces the subprogramme for the promotion of doctoral training (PREDOCS), certain errors have been detected that need to be corrected.

With regard to the promotion of pre-doctoral training on industrial PhD programmes (INDUSTRIAL PREDOCS).

Purpose

It should state:

The category is organised by a grant award mechanism based on the call for industrial mentions from the National Research Agency. Applicants shall accredit they have submitted an application to the second grant call corresponding to the year 2024 for doctoral training at corporations and other institutions (Industrial PhDs) in 2024-2.

Award Mechanism

Where it states:

1. All individuals who submitted an application to the 2025 call for pre-doctoral recruitment grants at corporations and other institutions (Industrial PhDs) within the deadline and in the correct manner, and opted to undertake a PhD thesis on a UIB PhD programme, are automatically included.

It should state:

1. All individuals who submitted an application to the 2024-2 second call corresponding to the year 2024 for pre-doctoral recruitment grants at corporations and other institutions (Industrial PhDs) within the deadline and in the correct manner, and opted to undertake a PhD thesis on a UIB PhD programme, are automatically included.

This correction of errors and all administrative steps arising from it may be appealed in the form and manner set out in Act 39/2015 of 1st October on the Common Administrative Procedure for Public Administrations.
